What Is Healing Roots Home Visiting Program?

Our mission is to give parents the education, tools, and community resources necessary to promote optimal early childhood development and strengthen families with trauma-informed and professionally trained Parent Educators.

Staff prepare personally formatted lessons and activities for each family that is served. Visits are conducted at home, by phone, and virtually.

The program aims to reduce isolation, broaden social support, and make families aware of the community resources available to them. The goal is to move the family toward a healthy and strong home environment in which the children will flourish.
